

2010-2011 School Supplies for Grades 6, 7, & 8

For All Grades:

1. Lined paper for class work and homework (not narrow lines, **White** only)
2. Pens, pencils, erasers, ruler with metric and standard measurement
3. Combination lock – **No Key Lock**
4. 2 large boxes of tissues (to be given to homeroom teacher first day)
5. Small pack of magic markers
6. Small pack of colored pencils (6 or 8 colors)
7. Box of crayons
8. Glue stick
9. Scissors (safety)
10. Glue – bottle
11. Book covers–**No Self-Sticking Covers!** (brown paper bags or cloth work well)
12. Pencil Pouch

Science 6, 7, 8

1. 1 3-subject spiral notebook
2. 1 folder with pockets (plastic will last all year)
3. loose leaf paper, pens, pencils
4. Old button down shirt to be used as a lab coat
5. Girls are to have a hair band to tie back hair during lab

Social Studies 6, 7, 8

1. 1 package of loose-leaf paper
2. Pencils and pens
3. Erasers
4. Highlighters
5. Ruler (not needed for 6th grade)
6. 3 subject spiral notebook
7. Folder (same color as notebook!)

Language Arts 6, 7 and 8

1. 5 subject notebook to be used only for Language Arts (MUST BE 5 subject!)
2. 2 pocket folders
3. 1 composition style notebook (marble style) to be used for L.A. only
4. Loose leaf paper
5. Index cards – 8th grade
6. One green pen, also blue or black pens (no pencils)

Reading 6

1. 1 subject notebook
2. 1 pocket folder
3. Index Cards
4. Loose leaf paper

Latin 6 and 7

1. 1 pack of 100 count index cards and file box to hold them
2. 1 three subject notebook – to be used only for Latin

Latin 8

1. 4-section notebook – to be used only for Latin
2. Loose-leaf paper for homework, tests, etc.
3. 1 pack of 100 count index cards

Literature 7

1. 1 two or three subject spiral notebook (for lit class only, please)
2. 1 pocket folder
3. 1 package of loose leaf
4. Highlighter – any color
5. Pens – blue or black only (no pencils)
6. Books – to be announced in September
7. One package of Post-its (3x3)

Literature 8

1. 1 three subject spiral notebook
2. 1 folder for handouts
3. loose leaf
4. pens - blue or black
5. 1 copy of To Kill a Mockingbird by Harper Lee (Warner Books edition or Grand Central Publishing edition) for October
6. 1 copy of Romeo and Juliet (No Fear Shakespeare edition) for January
7. 1 highlighter or sticky notes to mark text

Math 6, 7, 8

1. 3-ring binder w/pockets (to be used for math only please)
2. Notebook filler paper
3. Graph paper (3 hole punched) – to go in binder
4. Calculator (not graphing) – really just needed for basic computation
5. Protractor
6. Compass
7. Ruler
8. Colored pencils (for graphing)

If your child would like to use a spiral notebook, please make sure it is 3 hole punched to fit in the binder

Religion 6, 7, 8

1. 1 subject spiral notebook
2. 1 pocket folder without clamps
3. Notebook paper
4. Blue or black ball point pens – **No Felt pens**

Health 6, 7, 8

1. 1 spiral subject notebook
2. 1 folder with pockets

Phys. Ed. 6, 7, 8

1. Ss Peter and Paul gym uniform
2. Gym shoes (not platform style)
3. Draw string bag for gym clothes
