Kevin Henkes: Some favorites are Kittens First Full Moon, Chester's Way, Chrysanthemum, Owen, and Lilly's Big Day.

Laura Numeroff: Some favorites are If You Give a Pig a Pancake, If You Give a Moose a Muffin, If You Take a Mouse to School, and If You Give a Pig a Party.

Robert Munsch: Some favorites are The Paper Bag Princess, I'll Love You Forever, We Share Everything, and Get Out of Bed.

P.D. Eastman: Some favorites are The Alphabet Book, Are You My Mother?, Go, Dog. Go!, and Red, Stop! Green, Go.

Dr.Seuss: Some favorites are Fox in Socks, Hop on Pop, Mr.Brown Can Moo! Can You? and The Shape of Me and Other Stuff.
